

Fireworks, Cromer 01 January 2018

Photography Competition

On 01 January 2018 we will celebrate Cromer's 19th annual Firework Display which began in 2000. Now in its sixth year this photography competition is open to all **amateur** photographers. We are delighted to announce that in addition to the main prize offered by our sponsor Hughes Electrical, we will for the first time have an additional prize offered by Titanium Fireworks.

Prizes

The winner of the main competition will have their winning photograph turned into the official poster for the 2019 New Year's Day Firework event as well as use in other promotional material. They will also win a LG 43" Full HD LED Smart TV courtesy of local Electrical retailer Hughes.

Titanium Fireworks will independently select their winning photo. The winner will be given backstage access to any of Titanium's Shows throughout the following year to photograph the set up and shoot from a unique angle during the show of the winner's choice. Please note that various restrictions may apply.

Brief: Cromer's Fireworks 2017

We are looking for photographs that really capture the spirit of the Fireworks in Cromer, so come along to Cromer on 01 January, bring your camera, photograph the event and get creative.

The competition entry deadline is Midday on Friday 19 January 2018. All winners and runners up will be invited to the Annual Town Meeting on 14 March 2018 at which the winners will be announced.

Photography Competition rules

1. Photographs must be taken in Cromer on 01 January 2018 and must be original and taken by you. It is the photographer's responsibility to obtain the appropriate permissions. By entering the competition you are agreeing to have the appropriate permissions.
2. All photographs must be sent by email (only one photograph per email) or by hard copy and must arrive BEFORE midday on Friday 19 January 2018.
3. Photographs may be in colour or black & white.
4. Entrants may enter no more than 3 different photographs.
5. Emails should be sent to fireworks@cromer-tc.gov.uk and postal copies to Firework Photography Competition, c/o Cromer Town Council Offices, North Lodge, Overstrand Road, Cromer, Norfolk, NR27 0AH.
6. Each entry should include the photographers name, address and phone number. (In the email accompany electronic submissions and on the back of hard copy submissions). Personal details will be stored and used for the duration of the competition, for the awarding of the prizes and for photo credits.
7. Photographs must be in JPEG format for electronic submissions or at size 7x5 or larger for hard copy submissions.
8. Photographs submitted by email should be no larger than 3MB and should not be edited.
9. Photographs submitted by email should contain no watermark or other identifying mark.
10. The competition is open to all amateur photographers.
11. All commercial rights to the images remain with the photographers with the following exception:
 - a. The New Year's Day Fireworks committee, Hughes and Titanium Fireworks have the right to use all entries in any future publicity material (print or electronic inc. Social Media) without payment – subject to crediting the original photographer. This includes the right to grant use of the image by third parties solely for the purpose of promoting future events.

12. The competition will be judged by a panel of independent judges who will be announced at a later date. Winners will be notified by email or phone, the judges' decision is final, and no correspondence will be entered into. Prizes are non-negotiable and non-transferable.
13. Judging will take place during February and winners and runners up invited to the Annual Town Meeting on 14 March 2018.
14. By entering the competition you agree to participate in any reasonable publicity which may be generated as a result of the competition.
